Definitions:

Citizen: A status of full citizen without qualification or restriction and must be equal in status to a native-born or naturalized citizen of the United States.

Resident: Means one who has established residency (not immigration status) by being physically present in a place for a minimum of one year with an intention to remain for an indefinite period of time. There is no temporary character to residency such as student, visitor, tourist, etc. The United States Government may grant permanent residence status pending admission to citizenship.
