



## ***Technical Notification 213***

**Dated: August 16, 2018**

**Re: Singles Skating – IJS Special Factor (Second-Half Jump Bonus) and IJS Program Component Factors for the Juvenile Short Program**

### **IJS Special Factor (Second-Half Jump Bonus)**

Per Rule 1071 (A)(8)(d), page 114 of the 2018-19 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook (<http://www.usfigureskating.org/story?id=84114>), application of the **IJS Special Factor (Second-Half Jump Bonus)** in singles events judged using the IJS will be applied as follows:

#### **Senior and Junior Singles Events:**

**Short Program** – Last one jump executed in the second half

**Free Skate** – Last three jump elements executed in the second half

#### **Novice, Intermediate, Juvenile and Adult Silver and Higher Singles Events:**

**Short Program** (where applicable) – None

**Free Skate** – Last three jump elements executed in the second half

### **IJS Program Component Factors for the Juvenile Short Program**

For Juvenile Singles Short Program events at nonqualifying competitions judged with the IJS, the following program component factors apply:

#### **Juvenile Boys/Girls Short Program**

##### **Component Factor – 1.0**

Skating Skills	1.80 (60%)
Transitions	Not Used
Performance	0.60 (20%)
Composition	Not Used
Interpretation of the Music	0.60 (20%)
